Ben is an FAA Certified Flight Instructor and internationally known expert in flight simulation, who has also hosted the recently discontinued Microsoft Flight Simulator Forum on MSN and appeared as the Flight Simulator columnist for the MSN Gaming Zone.

The new site fulfills many needs. "The Virtual Pilot Center not only replaces the void left when MSN discontinued their former moderator and support base and the upcoming demise of CompuServe's FSFORUM," Ben explains, "but it is also a place for real-world pilots to get valuable flight services." As Ben points out, with flight simulation software gaining acceptance as a legitimate real-world flight training aid, the virtual and real worlds of aviation are merging. "The Virtual Pilot Center is a place for virtual pilots to have fun while learning more about aviation, and it is also a place for real-world pilots to become better aviators."
